ELIZABETH SPICER AND WALTER SHORT MARRIED

On 25 August, 1836, Thomas and Leah Spicer had the joy of seeing their eldest daughter, Elizabeth, married to Walter Short. Walter, born in Jamestown, Cornwall, was the second son of Edward Short, farmer, and his wife, Charity, nee Gibbs.

The marriage was celebrated in Holy Trinity Church, Kelso, by the Revd John Espy Keane. Elizabeth's brother, Edmund, Richard Mutton and John Hughes, all of Bathurst, signed the register as witnesses.⁶²
